



NORTHWOOD LANDSCAPE CURVED GARDEN

THE CONTRACTOR

Northwood Landscape is a Herefordshire-based landscaping contractor specialising in full garden renovations, patios, lawns, fencing and bespoke outdoor spaces. The company places a strong emphasis on thorough groundwork, attention to detail and durable installations designed around the individual needs of each client.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The homeowners wanted to create an outdoor space with a distinctive character. Although an existing timber garden room was to be retained, the surrounding area felt unfinished and required a more considered layout.

Northwood Landscape developed a design based around sweeping curves. Flowing planting beds and a self-binding gravel pathway were introduced to guide movement around the garden, connect the different areas and draw attention through the space.

KEY REQUIREMENTS

- Create smooth and consistent curves throughout the garden.
- Provide a durable separation between planting beds and pathways suitable for a restricted-access installation.
- Prepare clearly defined planting areas for the homeowner.

PRODUCT

CORE EDGE is a flexible steel landscape edging system manufactured in the UK from high-quality 1.6mm mild steel. Suitable for defining lawns, planting borders, patios and pathways, the system can be formed into flowing curves while providing a strong and lasting separation between adjoining surfaces.



Its flexibility allows for flowing curves as well as sharp, defined lines, making it ideal for both residential and showpiece gardens.



THE CHALLENGES & THE SOLUTIONS

Restricted access presented a key challenge, as a staircase prevented machinery from reaching the garden. All materials therefore had to be transported and installed by hand, requiring careful planning throughout the project.

CORE EDGE was used to form the sweeping curves between the planting beds and self-binding gravel pathway. Its flexible steel construction allowed Northwood Landscape to create smooth, consistent lines while providing a strong and durable separation between the different surfaces.

Despite the access restrictions, the contractor successfully delivered a distinctive garden layout that connected the existing garden room, new pathway, planting areas and bespoke ironwork.

SUMMARY

CORE EDGE helped Northwood Landscape turn an unfinished garden into a distinctive and carefully planned outdoor space.

The flexible steel edging enabled the contractor to form the sweeping beds and pathway boundaries that were central to the design, while providing the durability required to keep those lines secure over time.

Combined with the self-binding pathway, prepared planting beds, existing garden room and bespoke ironwork, CORE EDGE helped bring the different elements together into one cohesive scheme. The result is a unique garden that meets the client's original brief and demonstrates how professional landscape edging can support detailed residential designs, even where site access is particularly challenging.
